RESOLUTION- 2021-OCT
TO ADOPT WARD PLAN AND TO COMBINE
MUNICIPAL WARD FOR VOTING PURPOSES.

October 11, 2021

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes, Section 5.15 requires all cities, villages and towns with a population of 1,000 or more to establish wards based on the results of the 2010 census and

WHEREAS, Section 59-10(3)(b) of the Statutes requires that each county board adopt and transmit to each municipal governing body in the county a tentative county district supervisory plan, dividing the county into districts and designating the approximate location and population of each ward proposed to effectuate the division of the county into districts, and

WHEREAS, these laws require that each municipality designate by consecutive whole number, geographical description and population, the various wards to create within the municipality, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Lenroot adopts wards 1 and 2 described as follows:

Ward 1 -Town of Lenroot –Population 931, and polling place at Lenroot Town Hall, 12215 N US Hwy 63, Hayward WI 54843: That part of the Town of Lenroot lying within the following described boundary line: Beginning at the northwest corner of the Town of Lenroot, the point of beginning; thence east along the north boundary of the Town of Lenroot to U.S. Highway 63; thence southwesterly along US Highway 63 to its intersection with Larsen Rd; thence northwesterly along Larsen Rd to its intersection with Pfeifer Rd; thence west along Pfeifer Rd to the intersection with Tag Alder Rd; thence west along Tag Alder Rd to the intersection with the Namekagon River; thence southwesterly (downstream) along the Namekagon River to the intersection with U.S. Highway 63; thence southwesterly along U.S. Highway 63 to the south boundary of the Town of Lenroot; thence west along the south boundary of the Town of Lenroot to the southwest corner of the Town of Lenroot; thence north along the west boundary of the Town of Lenroot to the northwest corner of the Town of Lenroot; the point of beginning.

Ward 2 - Town of Lenroot – Population 406, and polling place at Lenroot Town Hall, 12215 N US hwy 63, Hayward WI 54843: That part of the Town of Lenroot lying within the following described boundary line: Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of the Town of Lenroot and U.S. Highway 63, the point of beginning; thence easterly along the north boundary of the Town of Lenroot to the northeast corner of the Town of Lenroot; thence south, then west, then south, then west along the east and south boundary of the Town of Lenroot to its intersection with U.S. Highway 63; thence northeasterly along U.S. Highway 63 to its

intersection with the Namekagon River; thence northeasterly (upstream) along the Namekagon River to its intersection with Tag Alder Rd; thence east along Tag Alder Rd to the intersection with Pfeifer Rd; thence east along Pfeifer Rd to the intersection with Larsen Rd; thence southeasterly along Larsen Rd to its intersection with U.S. Highway 63; thence northeasterly along U.S. Highway 63 to the north boundary of the Town of Lenroot, the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above wards (1 & 2) created above are hereby combined for voting purposes, so as to share the common polling place indicated and such combined wards shall use common voting machines and separate returns shall not be maintained for the combined wards at any election.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Town Clerk, who shall transmit a copy to the county clerk within five (5) days of its adoption and that this resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded, in accordance with Wis.,stats., or until a new division is made following the next federal decennial census.

This resolution effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis Stats.
