APPROVAL OF MINUTES: September 13th, 2021 Regular Town Board Meeting Minutes. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Supervisor Bandow 2nd the motion. All in favor. 4 yes, 0 no. Motion carried. **September 13th, 2021 Public Meeting Minutes:** Supervisor Jack Sjostrom made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Supervisor Bandow 2nd the motion. All in favor. 4 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF THE COMBINED CLERK & TREASURER REPORT: Supervisor Jason Sjostrom made a motion to approve the **September 13th, 2021, Combined Clerk & Treasurer Report.** Chairman Christians 2nd the motion. All in favor. 4 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: Mr. Art Dittman is requesting to purchase a small piece of town property, [on Ewig Rd - 2.37 acres, with 650 'blacktop road frontage and is zoned F-1 Forestry]. His property has a septic field issue that cannot be fixed without an extension to his property. The Board noted that if they do sell, it would have to be put out on bids. They suggested that Mr. Dittman, should get a perk test at the area he would like to buy to make sure that piece of property would pass the test. Mr. Dittman understood the test would be done at his expense and if test is acceptable we would move on to the bid process. The Board will place his name on the November Agenda.

OLD BUSINESS: New Dump Truck should arrive in two weeks. New Grader before the end of the year.

ZONING: Conditional Use Applications for Todd's Redi Mix. Resident #1: spoke in regard to Todd's Redi Mix Conditional Use Applications. He would like to see some form of control for following the rules and restrictions. At this point in time they are running the crusher from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. It is understood the need for gravel and concrete, but any extension of the gravel pit does not fit in with our Comprehensive Plan. The noise is extremely distracting to all neighbors. Would they consider crushing from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm. Resident # 2: concerned regarding a buffer and restoration of the area and the road. Board stated where the town road ends, no other road exists. Land owners allow the ATV's and snowmobiles to cross their properties. Todd's Redi Mix Manager agreed to hours of crushing from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. These hours do not affect his cement plant. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom made a motion approve the Conditional Use Applications for #21024 - #21-025 - #21026 on contingent that Todd's Redi Mix change their hours for crushing only from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. Chairman Christians 2nd the motion. All in favor. 4 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.
