PLEDGE OF ALLEGIENCE:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: September 2025 Lenroot Town Board meeting minutes. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom motioned to approve the minutes, Supervisor Danielson 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.

Lenroot Cemetery Committee Minutes: Clerk read the 16 Sept 2025 Cemetery Committee meeting minutes. Supervisor Jason Sjostrom made a motion to approve the minutes as read, Supervisor Jack Sjostrom 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.

COMBINED CLERK AND TREASURER REPORT: Lenroot Town Treasurer Rebecca Brunner-Stroede stated that the balances between the treasurer and the clerk's accounts balanced and that the existing balance is \$744,589.51. Supervisor Bandow made a motion to approve the Clerk/Treasurer combined reports. Supervisor Danielson 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT:

OLD BUSINESS: Chairman Christians addressed the request by Tony Weber, 15154 W Nelson Lake Rd to have a speed study done on the 45 MPH speed limit on Nelson Lake road by his house. After meeting with the County Road Commissioner, Chairman Christians noted the normal town speed limits are 55 MPH and it's already been reduced to 45 MPH. Speed studies are costly and the length limitations would not make sense to limit the speed just in front of his house. Technical guidance from Patrolman Eric Vortanz led the Town to suggest adding pedestrian signs with speed limits suggesting 35 MPH.

Complaints regarding Trailers and Park models being used as permanent structures. These are allowed as long as there's building permit in effect. These will be assessed if they are on blocks.

ZONING: Proposed Amendment for Camping Cabins OPTION F. Supervisor Danielson motioned to approve the 30% maximum allowable of Camping Cabins modifications within a campground, Supervisor Jack Sjostrom 2nd the motion. Four yes, one no - (Supervisor Bandow) stated he believes no modifications should be allowed. Motion passed.

ACTION ITEMS: Town Road Adoption Policy. Existing policy for town roads. Chairman Christians proposed to accept private roads as town roads without blacktop as long as they are up to all other town road standards. This is currently in draft with continued discussion in the coming months. Chairmen Christians motioned to table until next meeting. Supervisor Badow 2nd. None opposed motion passed.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Budget workshop 29 October 6:00pm.

Lenroot town officials all agreed to have their phone numbers on the Lenroot town website. Longterm Lease agreements for club buildings on Lenroot properties have been drawn up and approved. Supervisor Badow motioned to accept the lease agreements for the two buildings on Lenroot lands. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom 2nd the motion. None opposed motion passed.

ROAD & BRIDGE REPORT: Mowing and Shouldering continues. All the bridges are seal coated.

TOWN OF LENROOT SEELEY RIVERSIDE CEMETERY: Supervisor Jason Sjostrom noted pricing updates falls in line with neighboring town actions.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Supervisor Jack Sjostrom made a motion to approve the monthly expenditures of \$66,802.71. Supervisor Danielson 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT: Supervisor Jason Sjostrom made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Badow 2nd the motion. None opposed, motion carried.
