PLEDGE OF ALLEGIENCE:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: April 2026 minutes. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom motioned to approve, Supervisor Bandow 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.

COMBINED CLERK AND TREASURER REPORT: Lenroot Treasurer Rebecca Stroede noted both the Clerk and Treasurer reports balanced at \$894,735.97. Supervisor Bandow motioned to approve the Clerk reports. Supervisor Mittlesdorf 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT:

OLD BUSINESS: 6 June Epic Bike Fest reminder

ZONING: James Farley, 11830N Mosquito Brook Rd Dwelling on A-1 Dist. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom motioned to provide town approval for LUP dwelling on A-1 zoned area. Supervisor Mittlesdorf 2nd motion. None opposed, motion passed.

ACTION ITEMS: Seeley Hills Vault Toilet discussion. Susan Bauer, president notes that club members feel its time to have a permanent vault toilet installed. Possible locations were discussed. Construction proposed would be wood over a concrete vaulted toilet. The board stated they would like to see a concrete or block wall structure to reduce maintenance. The Seeley Hills Club is asking for permission to install and looking for the town board to cover 50% of the cost. They estimate cost at under \$4,000.00. The board asked the group to do some more research in construction, location, and cost and update the town board at a future meeting. The board is amenable to splitting the cost of the toilet.

Bids Lenroot Blacktop and Crack Sealing discussed. One bid for blacktopping received by Monarch Paving Co, 768 US HWY 8, Amery WI. \$385,340.00 for Erickson, Nelson Lk, Dam, Norway Pt roads, Gerlach Landing Parking lot. Supervisor Jack Sjostrom motioned to accept the Monarch Paving bid to blacktop noted roads, Supervisor Bandow 2nd. None opposed. Motion passed.

Crack sealing – Four bids received. Winning bid was the lowest bid from Superior Sealers, LLC 22024 CNTY HWY SS, Bloomer WI at \$13,538.00 for a list of eleven roads within Lenroot.

Other bidding companies: Sealtech INC \$18,616.25, Roy's Sealcoating \$18,280.00, Fahrner LLC Supervisor \$33,360.00. Supervisor Bandow motioned to accept bid from Superior Sealers, Chairman Christians 2nd the motion. None opposed, motion passed.

Tricky Trout Triathlon 25 July. Matt Wheeler. – Supervisor Mittlesdorf motioned to approve. Supervisor Bandow 2nd. None opposed. Motion passed.

Disposition of Old Lenroot Plow Truck. Chairman Christians suggested the board sells the old truck.

DISCUSSION ITEMS: Revisit Lenroot Town Ordinance Regarding Time Periods Trailers Allowed to Stay on Property. 2004 Lenroot town adopted the option that trailers on vacant land must be removed between 1 Dec – 1 March. The board agreed to not make any exceptions to the current option the town has been following.

ROAD & BRIDGE REPORT: New truck is coming. Town hall generator is not running. The crew is having a mechanic to look into it.

TOWN OF LENROOT SEELEY RIVERSIDE CEMETERY: Cemetery meeting was held last month with main topic about Memorial Day services.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Supervisor Jack Sjostrom made a motion to approve the monthly expenditures of \$27,974.50. Supervisor Bandow 2nd the motion. None opposed. Motion carried.
